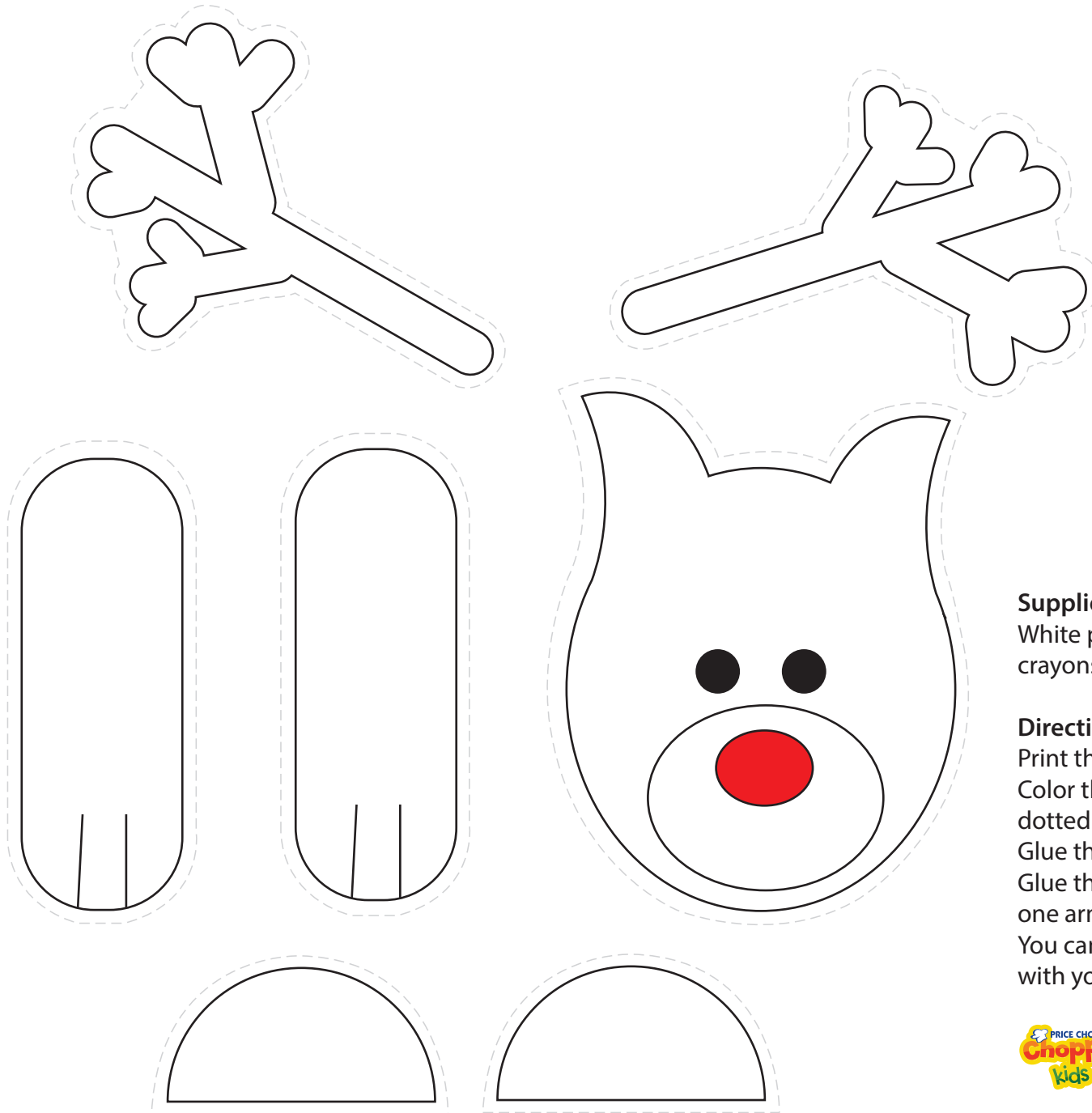


# REINDEER POPCORN CUPS



## Supplies:

White paper cup, printer, paper, glue, markers or crayons, scissors

## Directions:

Print this page and the recipe page.

Color the reindeer parts and cut them out on dotted lines.

Glue the face and paws to the front of the cup.

Glue the antlers to the back of the cup, and glue one arm down each side of the cup.

You can make the recipe provided or fill the cup with your favorite treat.



## REINDEER POPCORN

You will need:

10 c of popped popcorn

3 Tbsp butter (sweet cream, salted)

3 c mini marshmallows

Red M&M'S®

FLIPZ® Chocolate Covered Mini Pretzels

Wilton® Candy Eyeballs

Wilton® Christmas Sprinkles



Directions:

Pop 10 cups of popcorn and salt it well. Make sure you get out all the un-popped kernels. (You don't want to bite down on one of those!) We pop our popcorn on the stove, but you can use air-popped or microwave.

To make the marshmallow mixture, melt butter in a medium saucepan. Once the butter is melted, add the mini marshmallows. Stir until the marshmallows are melted, then turn off the heat.

Slowly pour the marshmallow mixture over the salted popcorn. Gently fold the marshmallow mixture in with the popcorn until the popcorn is mostly covered.

Pour the popcorn onto a cookie sheet lined with no-stick foil to cool.

Once cooled, pour your sweetened popcorn in a bowl or in the reindeer popcorn cup you made, and add the Wilton® Christmas Sprinkles.

Next, gather the ingredients you'll use to create your reindeer: Red M&M'S®, Wilton® Candy Eyeballs and FLIPZ® Chocolate Covered Mini Pretzels.

Gently snap the pretzels in half to make your reindeer antlers.

Then create some reindeer faces throughout the bowl of popcorn with your candy eyeballs, Red M&M'S® nose and pretzel antlers.
